

Georgia's Confederate Pension Applications

Following the Civil War, many of the Confederate states awarded pensions to the Confederate veterans, and/or their widows. The dates and criteria for receiving the Confederate Pensions varied from year to year and from state to state.

The first Confederate Pension Act in the state of Georgia was passed in 1879, providing artificial limbs for Confederate veterans. Later Georgia would extend the claims to the loss of eyes and hearing (1886) and the disabilities of age and poverty (1894). In December 1890 benefits were extended to widows who were married soldiers during the war and for Confederate soldiers who died in service or afterwards from wounds or diseases contracted while they were in Confederate service. By 1899, widows were provided coverage if they were unable to provide a living for themselves because of poverty, age, infirmity, or blindness. Eligibility requirements changed from year to year so it is impossible to relate each change in this article.

In all cases proof of eligibility for the existing Confederate pension requirements had to be submitted to the state in which the veteran or his widow was a resident. These applications provide the genealogist with valuable information. The soldier's application generally includes the name of his unit, dates of enlistment and discharge, number of years of continuous residence in the state of Georgia, and in some cases his date and place of birth.

Widow applications generally supply the name of her husband, name of his unit, date of their marriage, the date of death of the husband, and her financial condition.

The Georgia Confederate Pension Applications are filed alphabetically by name within the county of residence at the time of the veteran's (or widow's) application. The records may be viewed at the Georgia Department of Archives and History in Atlanta.

Descendants of Hezekiah Woodward (ca. 1760–1834)
A Brief Sketch of Three Generations

This sketch of the descendants of Hezekiah Woodward was compiled from secondary sources and data supplied by various subscribers who are descendants of Hezekiah Woodward. Admittedly, original documents and biographical information are sadly lacking. Any readers with further details and/or copies of original documents for this family are invited to send them to the editor.

Superscript numerals following a given surname represent the generation number, while the superscripts dispersed throughout the narrative correspond to the reference notes at the end of the article. When a "+" precedes the child's number, more information on that individual appears later in the article.

1. Hezekiah¹ **Woodward**, son of Francis **Woodward** and Wenefred **Martin** was born about 1760,¹ and died about the age of 73 after 10 March 1834 when he made his will.² He married a woman named Mary [--?--] (place and date of this marriage are currently unknown).

On 10 March 1834, Hezekiah Woodward wrote his will in Madison County, Tennessee, in which he left the all of his estate both personal and real to his children as follows:³

To my oldest daughter, Elizabeth Martin, fifty dollars. I also will her first children she had by Giles Bowers, one hundred & fifty dollars. The money to be left in Thomas F. Woodward's hands to be divided between them as he sees proper.

To my oldest sons heirs William Woodward's daughter, Eliza Raibourn, one hundred dollars.

To my second son Francis Woodward ten dollars.

To my second daughter, Nancy Dooly's heirs five hundred dollars.

To my third daughter Delilah Lawrence one hundred fifty dollars.

To my fourth daughter Winiford Calhoun five hundred dollars.

To my third son Hezekiah Woodward, five dollars.

To my fourth son Thomas F. Woodward my black boy, Sam.

The balance of my estate if any, to be divided in the same proportion among my heirs.

Hezekiah named his son T.F. Woodward to execute his estate. The will was signed by "Hazeliah" Woodward (Seal) in the presence of E.H. Nixone, and Samuel (x) Leston [his mark].

Hezekiah Woodward and Mary [--?--] had the

following children, probably born in Virginia (birth order according to his will):

- 2 i.Elizabeth² **Woodward** married, first, Giles **Bowers** who died in 1819.⁴ She married, second, George Washington **Martin** who became the guardian of the Bower Children. The Martins had three children.⁵
- + 3 ii.William **Woodward**.
- + 4 iii.Francis Marion **Woodward** was born 1787.⁶
- 5 iv.Nancy **Woodward** married James **Dooley** 5 June 1813 in Wilson County, Tennessee.⁷
- 6 v.Delilah **Woodward** was born 12 May 1791,⁸ and died June 1875 in Smith County, Tennessee,⁹ at age 84. She married Edward **Lawrence** 29 January 1810 in Wilson County, Tennessee.¹⁰
- 7 vi.Winifred **Woodward** married James Calhoun 7 November 1812 in Wilson County, Tennessee.¹¹
- + 8 vii.Hezekiah W. **Woodward** was born 19 July 1795.¹²
- 9 viii.Thomas F. **Woodward** was named executor of his father's estate.¹³

3. William² **Woodward** (Hezekiah¹) who may have died prior to 10 March 1834.

He married Jane **Bradley** 24 December 1812 in Wilson County, Tennessee.¹⁴ [Editor's note: A William Woodward is also shown to be married to Elizabeth **Harris** 29 April 1812 in Wilson County, Tennessee.¹⁵]

William Woodward had at least one known child:

- 10 i.Eliza³ **Woodward** who was born before 10 March 1834.¹⁶

4. Francis Marion² **Woodward** (Hezekiah¹) was born in Virginia 1787,¹⁷ and died 15 September 1839 in Franklin County, Tennessee,¹⁸ at age 52. His remains are interred in Kitchens Cemetery, in Winchester, Franklin County.¹⁹

He married Jane **Brandon** 21 February 1810 in Wilson County, Tennessee.²⁰ Jane was born 7 June 1792 in Burke County, North Carolina, daughter of Josiah **Brandon** and Rachel **Brown**, and she died 1864 in Tennessee,²¹ at age 72.

Francis Marion Woodward and Jane Brandon had the

following children:²²

+ 11i.Josiah Brandon³ **Woodward** was born 6 June 1811.

+ 12ii.Lemuel S. **Woodward** was born 17 May 1813.

8. Hezekiah W.² **Woodward** (Hezekiah¹) was born in Virginia 19 July 1795, and died 2 February 1858 in Nashville, Davidson County, Tennessee, at age 62.²³

He married Linda Mira **Jennings** 20 April 1816 in Christian County, Kentucky.

Hezekiah W. and Linda Mira (Jennings) Woodward had the following child:

+ 13i.Elizabeth H.³ **Woodward** was born about 1827.

11. Josiah Brandon³ **Woodward** (Francis Marion², Hezekiah¹) was born in Lincoln County, Tennessee 6 June 1811, and died 13 September 1909 in Katemcy, Mason County, Texas, at age 98.²⁴ His remains are interred in Katemcy.

He married Nancy Jane **Kitchens** 1829. Nancy was born 22 June 1803 in Kentucky, daughter of Samuel **Kitchens** and Martha **Brooks**, and died 17 May 1885 in Katemcy, at the age of 81.²⁵

Josiah Brandon Woodward and Nancy Jane Kitchens had the following children:

14i.Martha⁴ **Woodward** was born in Tennessee about 1830.²⁶ She married James **Kitchens** 11 August 1850 in Franklin County, Tennessee.²⁷

15ii.Elinor C. **Woodward** was born in Kentucky 1832.²⁸

16iii.Eliza S. **Woodward** was born in Tennessee 1833.²⁹

17iv.Richard R. **Woodward** was born in Tennessee 1834.³⁰

18v.Samuel K. **Woodward** was born in Tennessee 31 August 1837, and he died November 1910 in Inglewood, Los Angeles County, California, at age 73.³¹

19vi.Nancy Amanda **Woodward** was born in Franklin, Tennessee circa 1838,³² and died 12 January 1929 in Levelland, Hockley County, Texas, at age 90.³³ She married Marion James **Lusk** (sometimes called "Bunk") 22 January 1857 in LaGrange, Fayette County, Texas.³⁴ Mr. Lusk died 15 March 1892 in Temple, Bell County, Texas.³⁵

20vii.Mary S. **Woodward** was born in

Tennessee 1839. She married (unknown) **King** probably before 1858.³⁶

12. Lemuel S.³ **Woodward** (Francis Marion², Hezekiah¹) was born in Tennessee 17 May 1813, and died 10 November 1891 in Temple, Bell County, Texas, at age 78. His remains are interred in Merrillton County, Texas.³⁷

He married Jane **Wagoner** 1834. Jane was born 13 February 1814 in North Carolina, and died 1878 at age 64.³⁸

Lemuel S. Woodward and Jane Wagoner had the following children:

21 i.Lemuel⁴ **Woodward** was born 1833.³⁹

22 ii.Josiah Polk **Woodward** was born in Merriltown, Tennessee 7 March 1843, and died 6 March 1891 in Jarrell, Williamson County, Texas, at age 47. He married Sarah Catherine **Raney** on an estimated date of 1867. Sarah was born 26 July 1844 in Tullahoma, Tennessee. She was the daughter of Giles Burdett **Raney** and Ruth **Hill**. Sarah died 5 December 1928 in Jarrell, Williamson County, Texas, at age 84, and her remains are interred in Corn Hill, Williamson County, Texas.⁴⁰

13. Elizabeth H.³ **Woodward** (Hezekiah W.², Hezekiah¹) was born in Todd County, Kentucky about 1827, and died after 1861 in Ballard County, Kentucky.⁴¹

She married William H. **Dillworth** 2 January 1851 in Christian County, Kentucky. William was born 20 March 1821, and died about 1891 in Ballard County, Kentucky, at age 70.⁴²

Elizabeth H. Woodward and William H. Dillworth had the following child:⁴³

23 i.Susan Theestah⁴ **Dillworth** was born in Christian County, Kentucky 14 November 1854, and died 29 November 1916 in White County, Arkansas, at age 62. She married John James **Stevens** 14 November 1868 in Ballard County, Kentucky. John, born 7 December 1839 in Kentucky, died 20 October 1911 in White County, Arkansas, at age 71.

Announcing a New Book

Descendants of Richard, Nathaniel, Robert, and Henry Woodward, New England 1589-1996. Compiled by Thomas R. Steadman. Privately published by the compiler, 12401 N. 22nd St., #H-304, Tampa, FL 33612-4630, 1996. xiv, 732 pp. Index. Hardcover. Price information not available.

Steadman undertook the gigantic task of revising two earlier New England Woodward genealogies in one volume—Norma Slater Woodward's *Descendants of Richard Woodward, New England 1589-1982* [Travelers Rest, S.C.: Privately printed, 1982] and Harold Edward Woodward's *Some Descendants of Nathaniel Woodward Who Came from England to Boston about 1630* [Boston: New England Historic Genealogical Society, 1984]. The material contains extensive additions to rectify incomplete data contained in former and three other Woodwards who came to the Massachusetts Bay Colony in the seventeenth century. The first ten of fifteen chapters are devoted to descendants of Richard Woodward. Successive chapters are devoted to descendants of John Woodward, Nathaniel Woodward, Robert Woodward, Henry Woodward, and allied Woodwards.

Unfortunately, the basic problems contained within Mrs. Woodward's work continue—the numbering system is unique and sometimes difficult to follow, and the referencing do not meet today's standards. In this writer's opinion, the generic references listed at the beginning of the book confusing at best. References such as "U.S. Census Records" and "LDS; Index Cards, Archive Records, International Genealogical Index" do not lead the reader to the original source of the data.

Anyone interested in Woodwards (including spelling variations) with New England origins will find this new work very useful.
