

### ***Woodwards in Spanish-American War Service*** (Excepting Regular Army)

The Spanish American War (sometimes called the "splendid little war") began in April 1898 and was over in August of that same year—about 5 months. In April when the Americans intervened to assist the Cubans in their conflict with Spain her armed forces needed strengthening and volunteer soldiers serving in existing state militia units were accepted into federal service. Additional units were also raised by states, territories, or the Federal Government to assist with the cause. By the time the U.S. became involved the Cuban insurgent forces were, probably, well on their way to defeating Spain. About 460 Americans were killed in battle or died of their wounds, but some 5,200 perished because of various diseases including malaria, dysentery, and typhoid. Among the Cubans who had seen the brunt of the struggle, casualties were much higher.

The list of Woodwards included within are those who were not in the regular Army during this short conflict. The master name index to those who served in the Spanish-American War is called the "General Index to Compiled Service Records of Volunteer Soldiers Who served During the War with Spain" [National Archives Microfilm Publication M871, reel 124 (126 rolls)]. Each index card supplies the name of the soldier, his rank, and the unit in which he served. Some cards also refer to miscellaneous personal papers (there are no compiled service records for persons whose index card contains this entry). If a name appears under more than one spelling it has been cross-referenced. A word of **caution**—the correct name of a volunteer soldier serving during the war with Spain may not appear in the index for various reasons, e.g. he may have served in the Regular Army, he may have served under a different name or used a different spelling of his name, or a proper record of his service may not have been made or the record may have been lost or destroyed.

There is a separate index for the organizations from Louisiana (M240, 1 roll), from North Carolina (M413, 2 rolls - roll 2: L-Z), and in the Florida Infantry (M1087, 13 rolls - roll 13: Wo-Personal Papers) [these records have not been abstracted herein]. More information about volunteers during the Spanish-American War may be found in the general correspondence of the Adjutant General's Office. An extensive name and subject index is available on microfilm as *Index to General Correspondence of the Adjutant General's Office, 1890-1917*, M698, 1,269 rolls.

Records of appointments and military service of

Marine Corps officers are widely scattered and are not readily available unless you know dates of appointment and service. You may wish to consult Edward Callahan's *List of Officers of the Navy of the United States and of the Marine Corps, From 1775 to 1900* (New York: L.R. Hamersly, 1901), then a researcher can seek documentation in the records for a person's commission or an abstract of his service. In some cases, the records show place of birth. Another aid in finding a marine officer who served during the Spanish-American War is the Register of Living and Retired Officer, 1899-1904, in Record Group 127, which lists each officer serving in 1899 and each officer commissioned during the years 1899-1904.

Pension records for this war are included in the "Civil War and Later" Series (National Archives Record Group 94, Records of the Adjutant General's Office) which relate chiefly to Army, Navy, and Marine Corps service performed between 1861 and 1916.

Through many years of research and correspondence, the compiler has collected approximately 2,000 marriage records for the surname Woodard/Woodward. Most of the marriages occurred during the Colonial and Westward Expansion Periods in America. A few of them were found in the parish registers of England at much earlier dates and some of them took place at much later dates throughout the various states of America. The book contains over 4,000 names which were found in the family records, marriage bonds, minister returns, and church records.

The principal subjects in each marriage are printed in alphabetical order and do not appear in the index. All other names do appear in the index.

This volume should be of great value to anyone researching Woodard/Woodward for the period from 1620 through the 1800s.

## In Memoria

After a sudden illness, **Grady James Woodward**, 91, died in an Anaheim, California on 27 Dec 1996. Graveside services were held 31 Dec at Forest Lawn in Cypress, California.

Mr. Woodward was the youngest and last survivor of 10 children living to adulthood born to Isham Alexander Woodward and Dora Isabelle Martin of Tails Creek, Gilmer County, Georgia. His grandparents were Wilson (Wilsie) Cleveland Woodward and Emelia Ann (Millie) Blankenship, natives of North Carolina who had moved to Gilmer County in 1850.

Grady James Woodward was reared on a ranch near Santa Rosa, New Mexico. He ranched, farmed, and was in business in New Mexico and Arizona before retiring to California in 1965. Mr. Woodward was a deacon for 44 years active in Southern Baptist churches across the west where he lived.

He is survived by a son Grady Woodward Jr. of Garden Grove, California, two daughters Leeta Ellis, Green Valley, Arizona, and Penny Moultrie of Brooks, Georgia, four grandchildren, and five great grandchildren.
