## Headstones for Union Civil War Veterans

National Archives series M1845 contains twenty-two reels of microfilm reproducing the card records of headstones provided for deceased Union Civil War Veterans, ca. 1879-ca 1903. These records are part of the National Archives Record Group 94 ~ Records of the Adjutant General's Office, 1780's-1917. According to the National Archives website, all regional branches have a copy of the microfilm.

The data below has been abstracted from M1845, Reel 22. In general the information cards contains names of the veteran; his rank, company and unit; Death Date; Cemetery; Location; Company supplying the headstone; and the Contract Date.

## Probate Packet of Levi Woodward (1846)<sup>1</sup> Part II

The last issue of *WOODWARDS We-Search* contained an abstract of Levi's will (dated 10 November 1846 and proved 11 December 1846) and a second document, "Summary of the 'sole and exclusive property' allowed the widow and minor children" (submitted 20 September 1847).

Although the probate packet of original papers was located for Levi Woodward and we've gleaned a lot of information, we should not stop here. The next step is to examine the records of the LaSalle County Probate Court. It is very possible that additional material will be found in the court minute books and estate volumes.

Let's examine additional documents within the probate packet of Levi Woodward who died in LaSalle County, Illinois between 10 November 1846 and 11 December 1846.

The third and last item in the packet was the "Appraisal Bill" of the personal property of the Estate of Levi Woodward, deceased, as appraised by E. Balwin, Ira L. Peck, and J.W. Armstrong on 2 June 1847. Appraisal bills are of vital importance since they can reveal detailed information concerning the economical status of the deceased as well as hints concerning his occupation and education.

The appraisal was filed and recorded [no date].

This appraisal bill, describes only the personal property of the deceased and not his real property. However, the document indicates that the home of Levi Woodward

contained comfortable furnishings. An extensive study of other appraisement bills during a ten year time period would allow us to compare Levi's household furnishings to others in his neighborhood.

Like miners who do not abandon a strike after they have found a few gold nuggets, we should not be satisfied with just a few tidbits without exhausting the search for information concerning our ancestors.

## Missouri Land Patents

Missouri is a public land state. In public land states federal lands (public domain) were distributed to individuals under various land acts enacted by Congress.

The primary purpose of distributing public domain lands was to encourage families to move West.

Land patents were issued through government land offices to indicated the transfer of land from the federal government to the individuals. Federal land offices were established as early as 1797. The first land office in Missouri was the Jackson land office (opened through an act of 17 Feb 1818), then the St. Louis land office in August 1818, and the Franklin land office which opened 2 November 1818. The Lexington, Palmyra land offices and others opened later.

The various congressional acts included cash sales, homesteads (beginning about 1862), military warrants for military service, timber culture, mining, etc.

Charles Woodward of Chariton County, Missouri, was the first Woodward to receive a land patent in Missouri—8 May 1819.
