## New Jersey Calendar of Wills, 1814-1817

The State of New Jersey has published a series of forty-two volumes relating to the Colonial, Revolutionary, and Post-Revolutionary History of the State of New Jersey. The series, edited by Elmer T. Hutchinson was printed in Trenton.

Data extracted for this article comes from volume 42 (First Series): Calendar of New Jersey Wills, Administrations, Etc., 1814-1817.

Page 028. **Apollo Woodward** a witness with Isaac Ballinger, Benjamin Smallwood, and Ezekiel Cooper to 1814, Nov. 14 will of Daniel Bates, of Woodbury, Gloucester Co.; proven Jan. 19, 1815.

Page 284. **John E. Woodward**: Calendar of Wills, 1814-1817 - Inventory made 2 Apr 1814, with Francis Lippincott, on estate of Barney Melhollen estate of New Hanover Twsp., Burlington Co.

Pages 287-8. **Apollo Woodward**: Will of Amos Middleton, of Chesterfeld Twsp., Burlington Co., dated 16 March 1813... Son Abel, 933 £; 1 note which he gave Apollo Woodward; also my cedar swamp. ...

Page 295. 1811, Mar. 11. Moore, Benjamin, of Hopewell Twsp., Hunterdon Co.; will of. Daughter, Elizabeth Moore (wife of William S. Moore), large looking glass, and to her son, Benjamin, my clock and case. To said grandson, Benjamin, the plantation whereon I live, adjoining the road from Pennington to Trenton, and lands of John VanKirk, Samuel Moore and others, containing 148 acres; also 50 acres adjoining same, and Aaron Hart, subject to payment of \$26.67 out of annual rent to grandson, **Benjamin Woodward**. If said Benjamin should die without issue, said plantation to my grandson, William Israel Moore (son of William S. Moore); all other real estate to be sold, and out of proceeds, \$130.33 to granddaughter, Sally Moore (wife of

Charles Moore). One half of remainder to daughter, Elizabeth (wife of William S. Moore). Interest of other half for use of **daughter, Sally (wife of Daniel Woodward)**, for her sole use and benefit, without hindrance from her husband, and at her death to be divided between her daughters, **Hannah, and Polly Woodward**; Executor - son-in-law, William S. Moore. Witnesses - Nathaniel Temple, Enoch Green, Charles Ewing. Proved July 24, 1815 at Trenton before William S. Pennington, Chancellor. File 2484 J.

Page 296. **Samuel Woodward** was a witness to the will of Henry Moore dated, 18 Feb 1811, of Upper Freehold Twsp., Monmouth Co. Other witnesses were William Asson, and Joseph Hodson.

Page 314. Will of William Northup, 16 Aug 1814, of Wantage Twsp., Sussex Co., Inventory includes notes of "**Jessey Woolward**, totaling \$200 considered 'doubtful'."

Page 338. **John E. Woodward** made an inventory on the estate of Joseph Powel of Northampton Twsp., Burlington Co., 4 Mar 1817, with Francis Lippincott. File 12945 C.

Page 379. Will of Francis Shinn, 12 Apr 1810, of upper Freehold, Monmouth Co.; to wife Martha, \$800 to be paid by son, Benjamin: also 2 beds and bedding, looking glass,

case of drawers, cow, 2 rooms in house, firewood. Grandson, Francis Burtis, all plantation bought of William Stevenson, and 37 acres bought of James Horner; also 5 acres bought of Cyrus Middleton estate, 16 acres of cedar swamp in Job's old swamp as bought of Samuel Lippincott, he paying to my daughter Vashti Burtis, \$800. Also to said daughter, 1 lot of cedar swamp bought of Caleb Lippincott's estate in partnership with **Robert and Samuel Woodward**; also \$1300, to be paid by son, Benjamin. son, Benjamin, the

plantation whereon I live and the plantation bought of Samuel Burtis; also all other estate, real and personal, he paying all my debts. Executors - son, Benjamin Shinn and Samuel Burtis. Witness - William Nutt, James Headley. Proved Jan. 28, 1814. 1814, Jan. 26. Inventory, \$13,569.6; made by Abraham Tilton, William Nutt. Includes amount due from estate of Barzillai Hopkins. File 9116 M.

Page 491. 1814, Mar. 14. **Woodward, Jethro**, of Upper Freehold Twsp., Monmouth Co.; will of. Oldest daughter, **Lucie Woodward** (whose mother was Ann Bucklow), 800 £ to be paid her when of age. Second daughter, **Sarah** (whose mother was the same), 500 £ when of age. Daughter, **Rebecca Woodward** (whose mother is Rachel Chafy), 400 £ Rachel Chafey is now with child by me and if said child should live, to have 400 £ also. All estate to be sold and proceeds (after debts and above legacies are paid) to be equally divided between all my children and Rachel Chafey. Executors - John Ridgway, Nickolas Waln. witnesses - William Elliott, Jacob Metsgers, Ann Elliott [signed by mark]. Proved Apr. 29, 1814. 1814, Apr. 7. Inventory, \$707.75; made by John Hankins, Apollo Meirs. File 9123 M.

Page 373. **Sarah Woodward:** among bequeaths of John Scott - "Residue of personal estate equally to cousins Job (son of Job Scott), living in Philadelphia and his half-sister, Sarah Woodward, Sarah (daughter of James Reid and any other children he may have living), Margaret (daughter of William Reid), who is living in the Genessee country, and Eleanor Reid. ... Will of John Scott, 8 Jan 1817, of South Brunswick Twsp., Middlesex Co., NJ.

## New Jersey: Family of Thomas Woodward

The Genealogical Magazine of New Jersey [volume 9 (1933-34): 38.] contained a brief account contributed by Edith C. Mercer of Minneapolis, Minnesota. Ms. Mercer supplied birth details found on a "photostat copy of a page from a manuscript book formerly the property of Thomas Early, and dated 1736." The births of Thos. Woodward, his wife, and children were recorded as follows (transcribed as found in The Genealogical Magazine of New Jersey):

- Tho: Woodward Born (Date not given).
- Johannah Woodward Born (Date not given).
- Jos: Woodward Born ye 2d Day of Jan'y Anno Domi 1716/17, 4<sup>th</sup> Day of ye week about sunrise.
- Mary Woodward Born 5<sup>th</sup> July 1718. 7<sup>th</sup> Day, about 11 at night.
- John Born Jan'y 11<sup>th</sup> 1719/20. 2d Day of ye week & Died April 10<sup>th</sup> 1724.
- Ezek' Born Octobr 16<sup>th</sup> 1721, about 10 o'clock at night, 5<sup>th</sup> Day of ye week.
- Rebekah Born July 28<sup>th</sup>, 1723 about 10 in ye fore noon, 2d Day. Took Sick Novem' 6<sup>th</sup> 1741, and Dy'd Jan'y 6, 1741/2.

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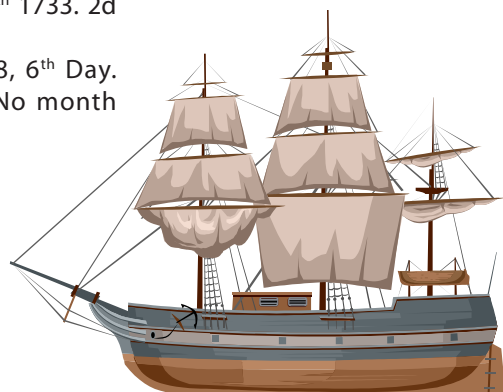

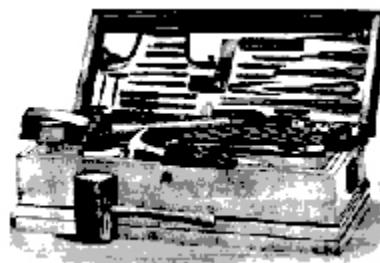

## Will of Jethro Woodward

Jethro Woodward of Upper Freehold, Monmouth County, New Jersey, wrote his will on 15 March 1814. His will was proven 29 April 1814 by William Elliott, Jacob Metsgers and Ann Elliott.<sup>1</sup> The will is transcribed below as it appears in the estate file. The microfilm image appears to be an exact image of the original document signed by Jethro Woodward and the witnesses present, William Elliott, Jacob Metsgers, and Ann Elliott.

I Jethro Woodward of the Township of Upper freehold and county of Monmouth do make this my last will and testamen declaring void all other wills and codicils by me made I give and bequeath to my older daughter Lucie Woodward whose mother was Ann Buck low Eight Hundred Pounds to be paid her when She becomes of age and to be allowed the Intrest for her maintainance I give and bequeath to my Second Daughter Sarah whose mother was Ann Buckelow five Hundred Pounds to be paid her when she becomes of age and to be allowe the Intest for her maintainings I give and bequeath to my Daughter Rebeca Woodward whose mother is Rachael Chafy four Hundred Pounds to be allowed the Intrest for her Main tainance and as Rachael Chafy is with Child by me and if that child should live I give and bequeath the said Child four hundred Pounds and to be allowed th Intrest for its maintainance and it is my will and Desire that my Executors here after named may Sell all my real & Personall Estate and after paying all my just debts & funeral Charges and all the above named legacies to divide the Residue equally between all my before named children and Rachael Chafy Share & Share alike and I do here by Consistute and appoint John Ridgway and Nicholas Waln[?] Executors to this my last will & Testa ment in whitness whereof I have hereunto set my hand Seal this fifteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred and fourteen Witness Present and fur this the day and year above written it is my will and Desire that all my children may be placi ed out or bound out by my Executors and that Rachael Chafy shall be provide for untill the child is fit to leav her

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## Death of G.C. Woodward, Attorney<sup>1</sup>

[15 Feb 1946, Philadelphia]

Graham Cox Woodward, a member of the Philadelphia bar for 40 years and a member of the Board of Revision of Taxes, died Wednesday night in Pennsylvania Hospital after an illness of two months. He was 65.

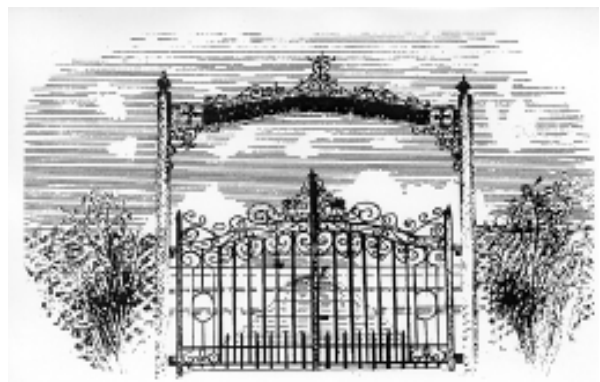
The son of Dr. Joseph Janvier Woodward, a famous surgeon who attended Presidents Lincoln and Garfield when they were shot by assassins, he was graduated from the University of Pennsylvania Law School in 1904. He was presidnet of the Law Academy of Philadelphia, known as the oldest institution of legal learning in America, in 1914. In 1931 he was a candidate for the Republican nomination for the State Supreme Court. He was an active member of the society of Friends, 15th and Race sts.

His first wife, Alice Weber Woodward, died in 1943. He is survived by his second wife, Irene F. Woodward and three daughters, Mrs. John W. Wagner; Mrs. Anthony C. Hopkins; and Miss Elizabeth C. Woodward.

Funeral Services will be held at 2 P.M. Sunday at Friend's Meeting House, 15th and Race Sts.
